
Mobile Application Configuration Service Release Notes 1.0.0

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Overview

This document describes the new features and known issues for the 1.0.0 release of Sugar's Mobile Application Configuration Service (MACS). MACS is available to OEM partners, implementation partners, and customers running Enterprise or Ultimate editions of Sugar.

Features

MACS enables partners and eligible customers (i.e. Enterprise and Ultimate) to create and distribute custom-branded versions of the SugarCRM Mobile app. MACS offers the following features and functionality:

- [Creating an App](#) : MACS enables you to create a new, rebranded Android and/or iOS app based on the SugarCRM Mobile app. You can:
 - Re-skin the SugarCRM Mobile app with your own logo and color themes
 - Preview any potential color and logo changes made to the app prior to its completion via the WYSIWYG interface
 - Preset your Sugar instance configurations and settings in your new app during compilation via Mobile Device Management (MDM) tools
 - Generate an app that can be used with any leading MDM vendors that support App Wrapping
- [App Signing in MACS](#): MACS connects to your Apple and Android developer accounts via items such as the iOS Distribution Certificate, iOS Provisioning Profile, and Android Package Name.
- [Downloading an App](#) : Easily download your rebranded iOS and/or Android app directly from MACS so it can then be distributed accordingly.
- [Distributing an App](#) : Apps created in MACS can be deployed to internal or external stores, including the Apple App Store and Google Play Store. It also allows you to deploy your app more securely via most MDM vendors.
- [Maintaining an App](#) : Upon future releases of SugarCRM Mobile, MACS allows you to download and redistribute updated versions of your app to take advantage of the latest SugarCRM Mobile features and fixes.
- **Getting Started Tutorial** : Upon logging in for the first time, we provide you with a Getting Started video for MACS.
