
Sugar Corporate 7.8.2.2 Release Notes

Sugar 7.8.2.2 is a security update released to address certain security vulnerabilities identified during our routine QA checks.

We strongly recommend that you install this update at the earliest opportunity. While we have not experienced any reported incidents relating to these vulnerabilities to date, failure to install this update could leave you exposed to malicious third party attacks. These vulnerabilities have been addressed in release 7.8.2.2 which is available for download from the Download Manager.

Administrators are strongly encouraged to upgrade their Sugar instances running 7.8.2.1 and prior to version 7.8.2.2 to prevent potential exploitation of these weaknesses.
