# Sugar Community Edition 6.5.11 Release Notes

## Overview

This document describes enhancements to existing features, known and fixed issues, supported platforms, and acknowledgments for Sugar Community Edition 6.5.11.

## Feature Enhancements

Enhancements to existing features for Release 6.5.11 are listed below:

- Calendar's More Information : Additional fields have been added to the pop-up More Information box within the Calendar module.
- Calendar View Persistence : A user's calendar will now preserve the last view setting (i.e. Week or Month) for the duration of the session.
- Completed Activities View Option : Users may now choose whether or not to display completed activities on their calendar using an option in the calendar's Settings panel.
- Dynamic Email From Address : The From email address and name may now be dynamic as specified on a workflow email template.
- Multiple Email Addresses as BCC : All To email addresses may now be easily moved to BCC.
- Lead Conversion Account : Existing account name populates when searching for account during lead conversion.
- vCard Error Detection : Creating records via vCard now includes formatting error detection.

## Fixed Issues

Due to the high volume of bugs fixed in Release 6.5.11, only prominent fixes are detailed below:

- 42158 : Bounced emails are not imported when monitoring multiple folders

- from the same Sugar bounce-handling inbox.
- 42874 : Sorting within panels in the View Status page of a newsletter campaign causes default marketing record filter to be disregarded.
  - 43368 : REST API calls requiring a response in JSON format instead receive text/html response.
  - 48697 : Invalid users appear as an option to receive records when reassigning records in the Users module.
  - 53231 : Teams selected in Advanced Search cannot be removed.
  - 55436 : Renaming a module does not update the name in a related record's flex relate module dropdown.
  - 56559 : Opening two quick create panels at once causes the second to open in a new browser tab.
  - 56642 : Quick creating a Lead or Content from within the Emails module does not auto-populate the email address.
  - 56917 : Attempting to send a campaign to an email address containing an apostrophe results in a database error.
  - 58711 : Related to field able to be modified from related record's subpanel despite field marked as uneditable in the user's role.
  - 59795 : Meetings' pop-up list view retains date value in searching after search has been cleared.
  - 60203 : Custom sort order not respected in Users' pop-up list view.
  - 60688 : Roles preventing viewing of email addresses of records fails to prevent user creating an email to the record and viewing the email address within the email's To field.
