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Overview

Fixed Issues

Sugar 6.5.24 is a security update released to address certain security vulnerabilities identified during our routine QA checks.

We strongly recommend that you install this update at the earliest opportunity. While we have not experienced any reported incidents relating to these vulnerabilities to date, failure to install this update could leave you exposed to malicious third party attacks.
