

HOW TO SEARCH FOR ALL OF YOUR ACCOUNTS **IN A CERTAIN AREA - ANDROID**

Did you know you can search for all your accounts (prospects or customers) in a certain area? So, if you're due to see a customer, why not run a zip/post code or town search to see if there are any accounts nearby to visit.

O1 From the navigation bar at the bottom of the screen, tap Accounts

Next, tap the circular menu button in 02 the bottom right hand corner of the screen and tap the Search icon that appears.



You will now see a list of Search Options.

Tap Search Fields to open up some further options.

Next, tap on Name and Account Number to untick them.

Finally, tick Post Code (Zip Code), Town or County (state) depending on what you would like to search for.

TOP TIP: WILD CARD SEARCH

By default, sales-i will run a full or partial search, however if you want to narrow your search down e.g. to a particular postcode area you can do this by adding an asterisk (*) to the end of your search criteria.
