# IBM Notes Plug-in Release Notes 2.1.5

## Overview

This document describes feature enhancements and fixed issues for the Sugar Plug-in for IBM Notes 2.1.5. For information about supported versions of IBM Notes, refer to the [Plug-ins Supported Platforms](#).

## Feature Enhancements

The following feature enhancements are included in this release of the Sugar Plug-in for IBM Notes:

- **Support for private events** : Events marked "Private" in IBM Notes will sync to Sugar with the subject line "Busy".
- **Archive deleted records** : Users can choose how to handle records in Sugar when they are synced with records that get deleted or archived in Notes.
- **Debug logging** : Three levels of verbosity are now available for the plug-in's logging level options.
- **Sugar sync for user invitees** : When syncing meetings from Notes to Sugar, both contacts and now Sugar users will sync with the meeting.

## Fixed Issues

The following issues have been resolved in this release of the Sugar Plug-in for IBM Notes. [Support Portal users](#) can use the following links for more details about each issue:

- [74234](#) : Account names that contain apostrophes do not sync properly from IBM Notes to Sugar.
- [74778](#) : Contacts fail to sync to Sugar from IBM Notes calendar invitee lists.
- [74876](#) : A java.lang.nullPointerException error occurs when syncing meetings from Sugar to the IBM Notes Calendar.
- [74877](#) : Meetings that are created in IBM Notes with an attachment do not copy the attachment to Sugar.
- [74792](#) : When the Sugar Plug-in for IBM Notes is set to "Only sync linked Calendar Records to Sugar", private activities in IBM Notes incorrectly sync to Sugar.
- [75735](#) : The Sugar Plug-in for IBM Notes looks for documents in the local

database even if the IBM Notes user is connected to a server database (e.g. Domino), resulting in a failure to find documents for sync.

- [75870](#) : Meetings from IBM Notes are unnecessarily synced to Sugar multiple times.
- [76247](#) : Certain field attributes in IBM Notes may interfere with sync activities.
- [76268](#) : Sugar throws an error when an incoming calendar item contains more text than Sugar allows.
- [76645](#) : An empty Due Date value in either Sugar or IBM Notes can prevent a record from successfully syncing.
- [76957](#) : Sugar contacts only retain the most recent meeting relationship synced from IBM Notes.
- [76987](#) : When a meeting attendee syncs their meeting from IBM Notes to Sugar before the organizer does, the attendees are removed from the meeting in IBM Notes.
- [76988](#) : A meeting attendee may be incorrectly promoted to the meeting organizer in IBM Notes if the attendee is using the Sugar plug-in but the organizer is not.
- [77193](#) : Regardless of directionality, one-way sync is not respected when an existing meeting is edited.

## Known Issues

- [74482](#) : Importing a vCard from IBM Notes to Sugar does not work as expected.
- [77895](#) : IBM Notes does not update synced meetings when the user edits the meeting in Sugar.
- [77924,77925](#) : Deleting the parent occurrence of a synced, recurring meeting will result in sync failure or deletion of the entire series on one or both sides.
