IBM Notes Plug-in Release Notes 2.0.0

Overview

This document describes feature enhancements and fixed issues for the Sugar Plug-in for IBM Notes 2.0.0. For information about supported versions of Outlook, refer to the [Plug-ins Supported Platforms](#).

Feature Enhancements

The following feature enhancements are included in this release of the Sugar Plug-in for IBM Notes:

- **Eclipse / Expeditor based architecture with Lotusscript for sync :** New architecture and design optimizes and enhances backend functionality, UI, and simplifies the sync process.
- **New widget client installation and Domino server deployment :** The new widget based installation process greatly simplifies installation and is no longer dependent on the Notes mail template.
- **Sugar REST API integration :** Sugar Notes Plug-in is now compatible with Sugar 7.x and utilizes Sugar 7's improved, REST-ful API.
- **Sugar menu :** Sugar Cube menu has been removed from the Notes Actions menu and now appears in the Notes Toolbar for ease of access.
- **Language support :** Chinese and Spanish are now supported.
- **All-day calendar event sync :** All-day calendar events are now supported for syncing.
- **Auto-sync improvement :** Sugar contacts may now be auto-synced without the need for Notes agents in the mailbox.

Fixed Issues
